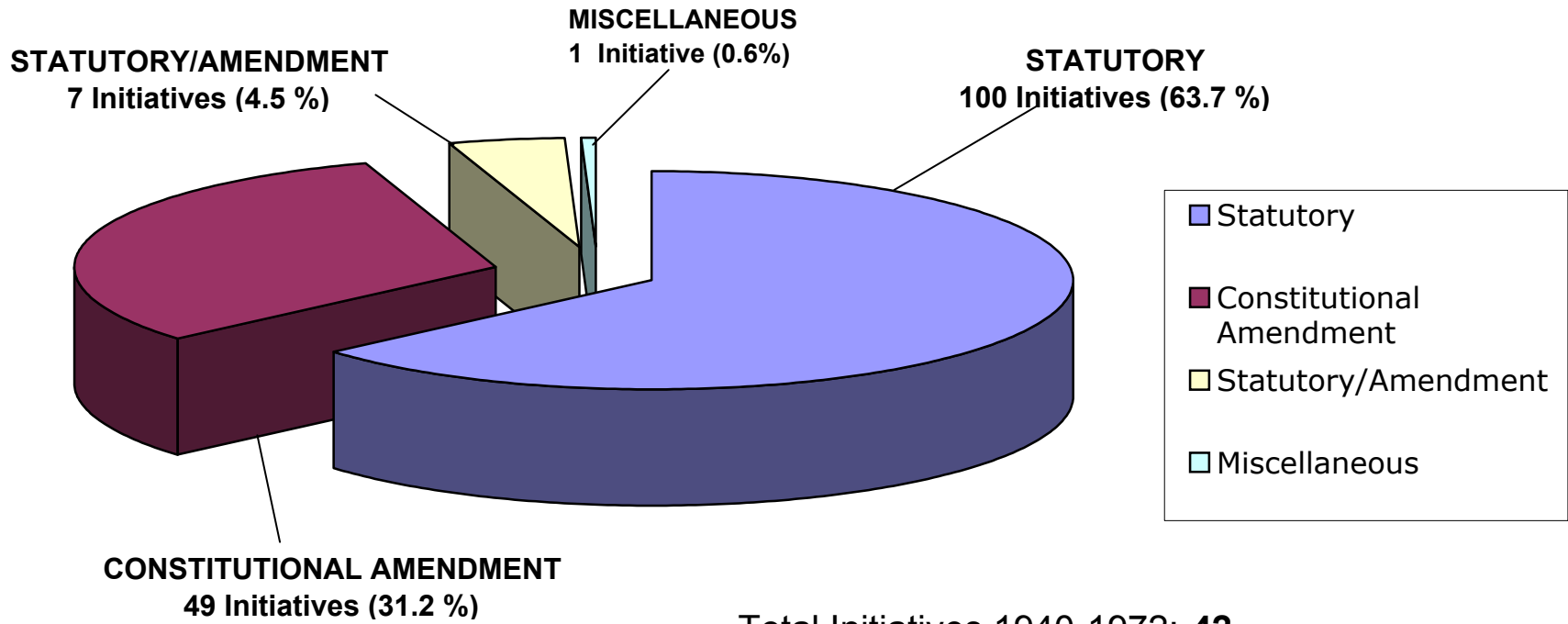

CA Initiatives 1972-2004 – Pass/Fail

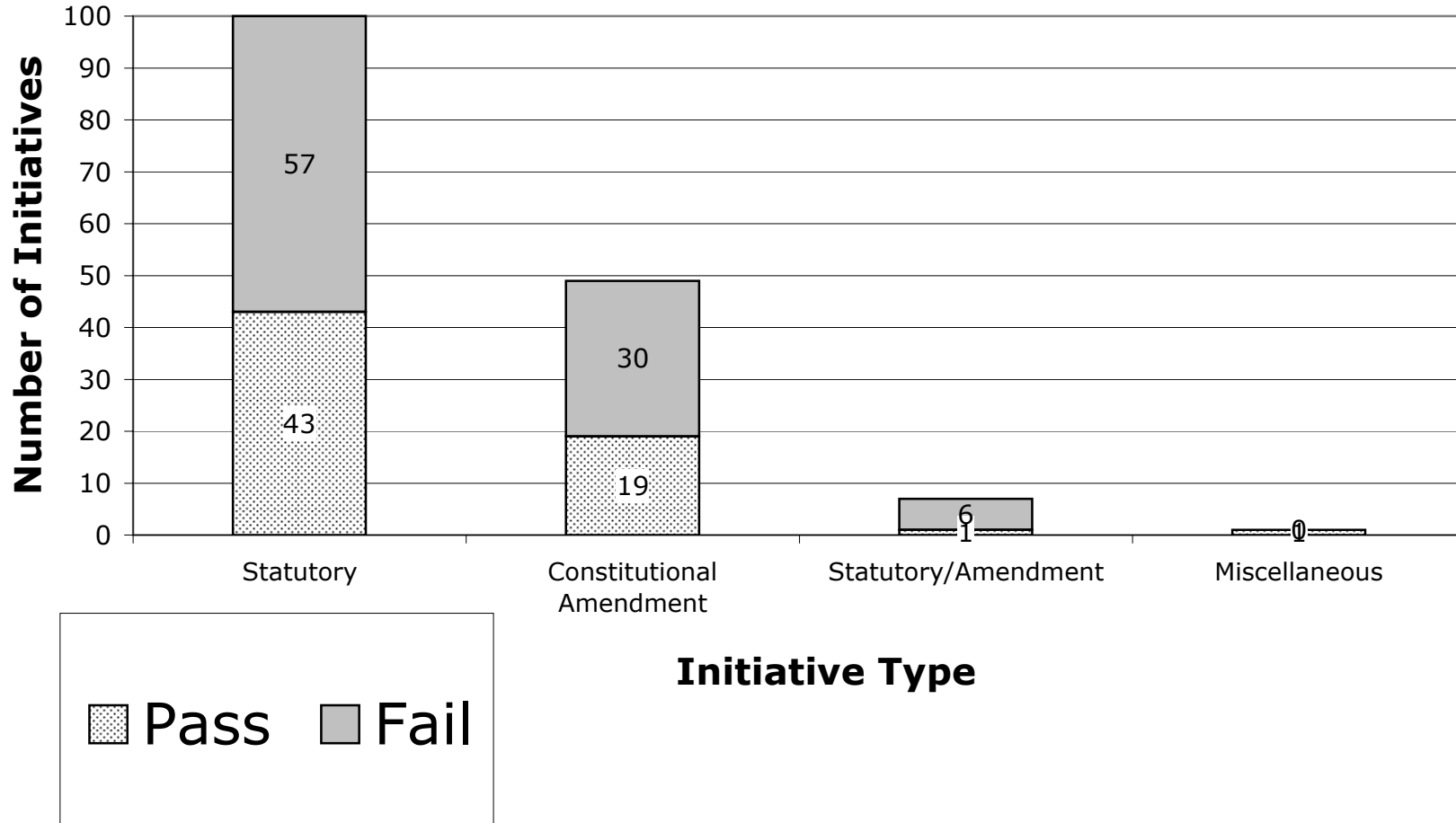

CA Initiatives 1972 to 2004, by Topic

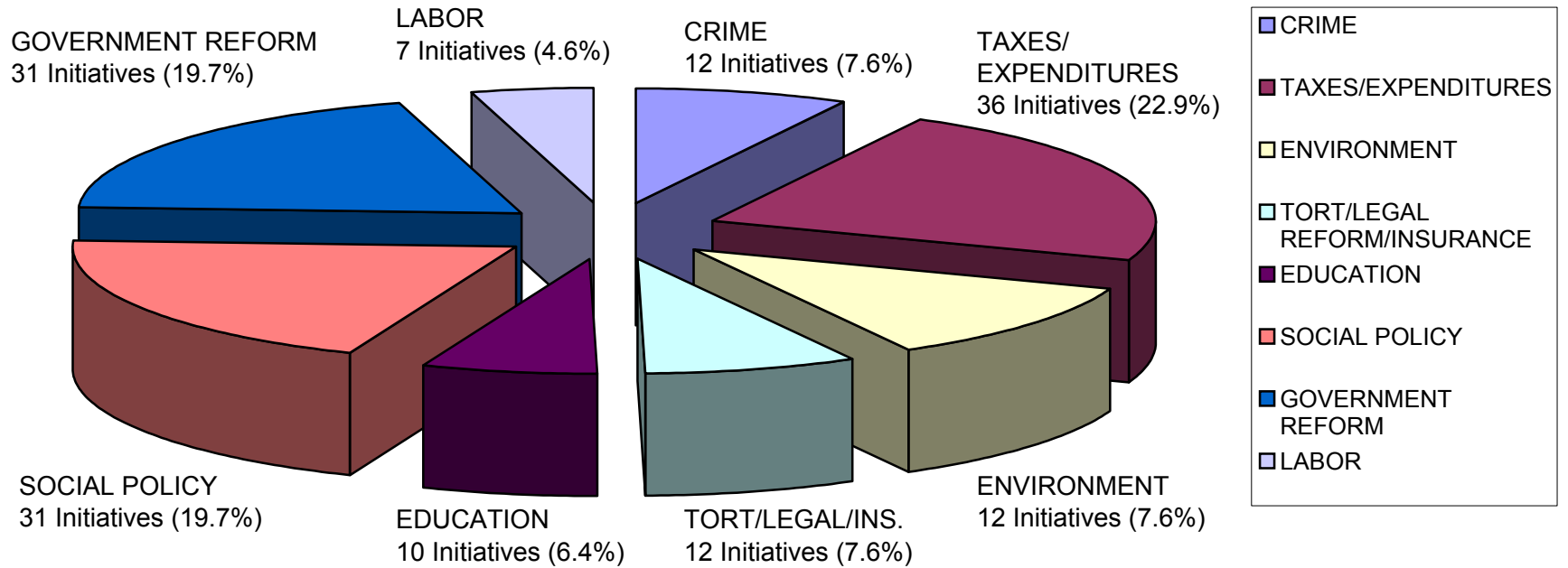
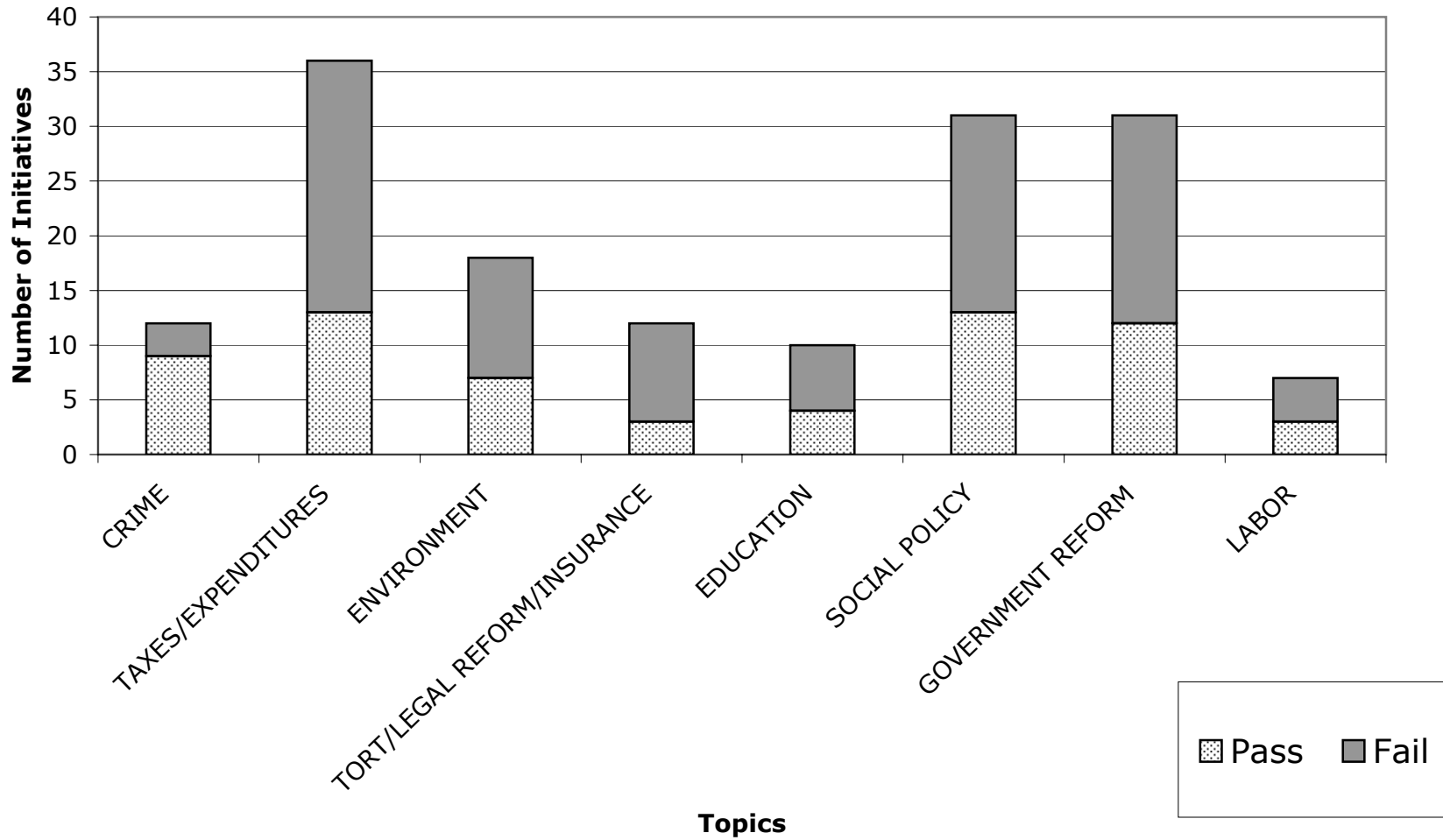

Initiatives by Administration

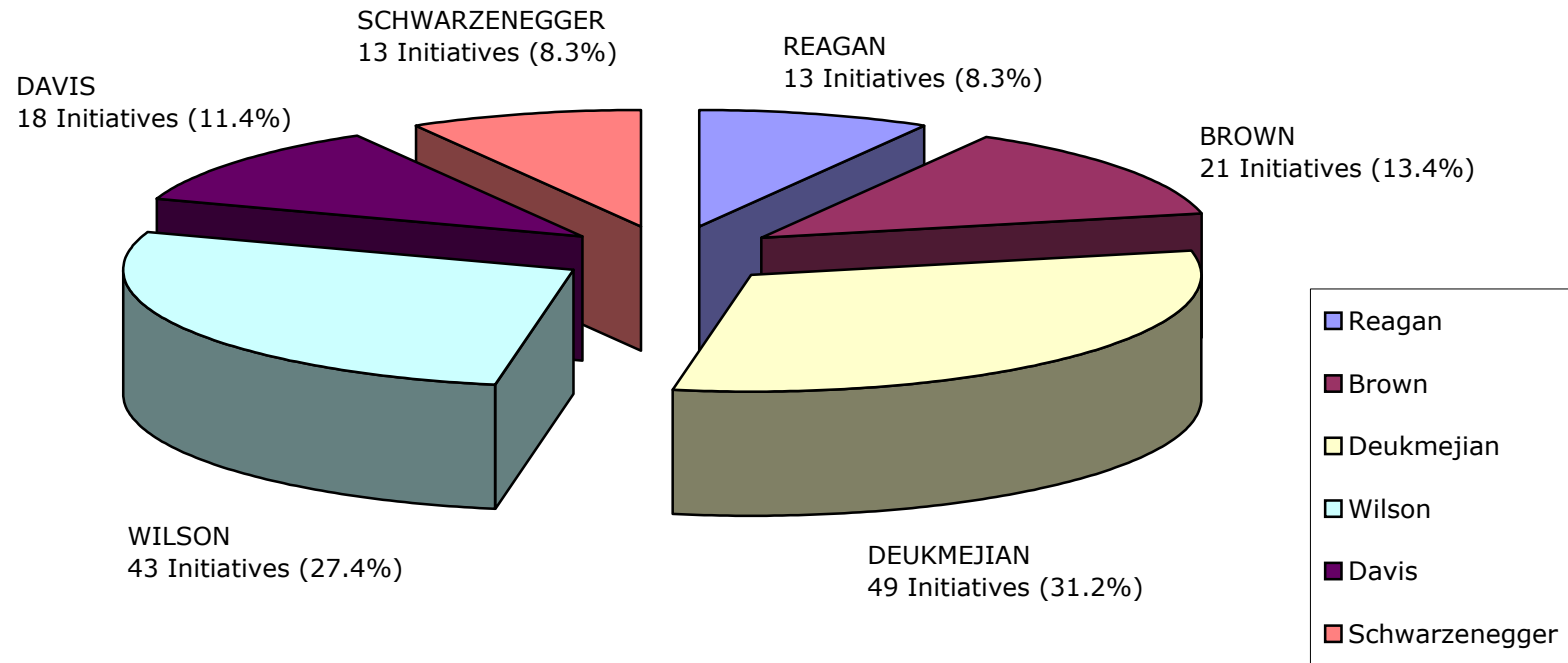

Pass/Fail Rates by Administration

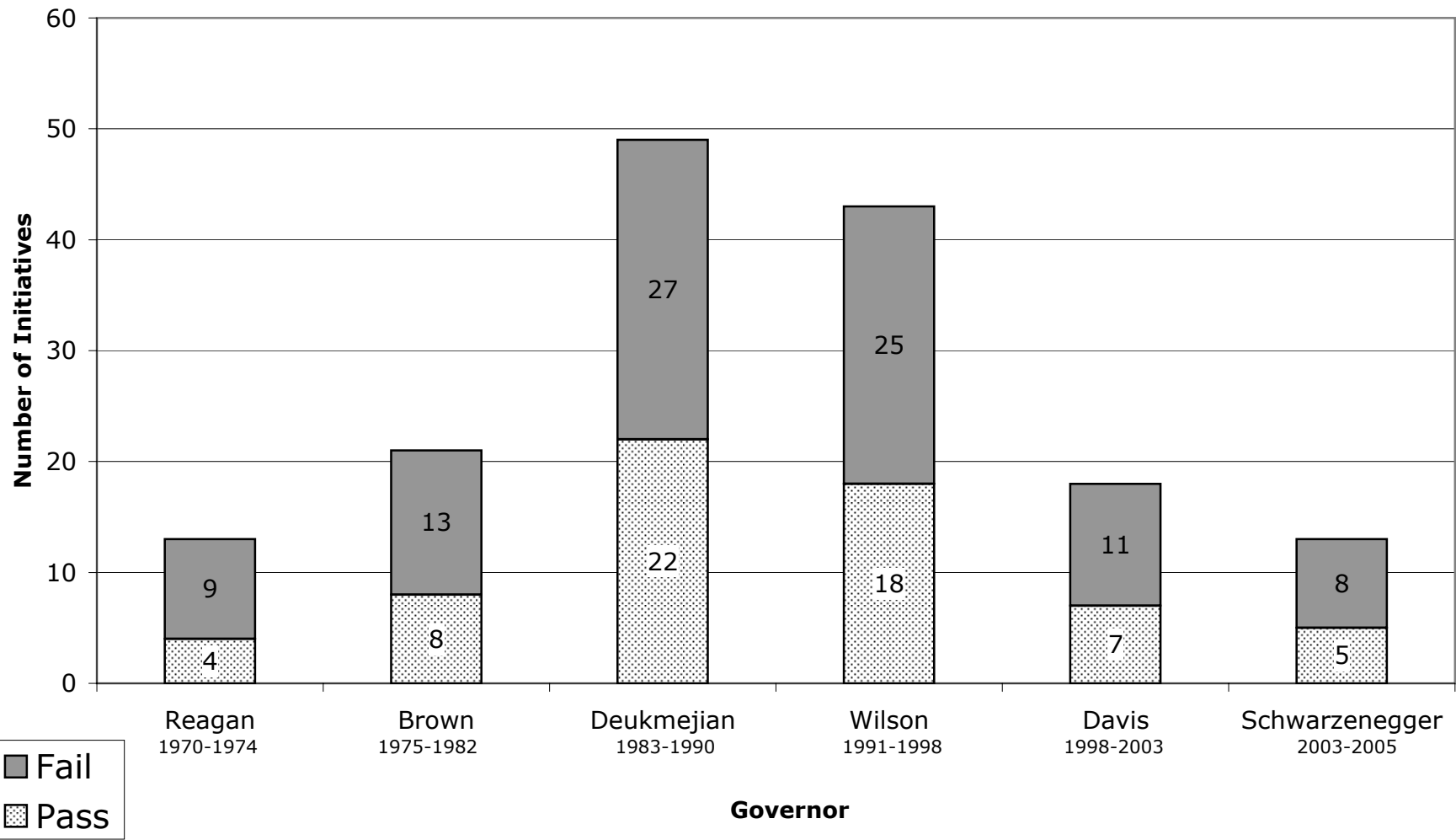
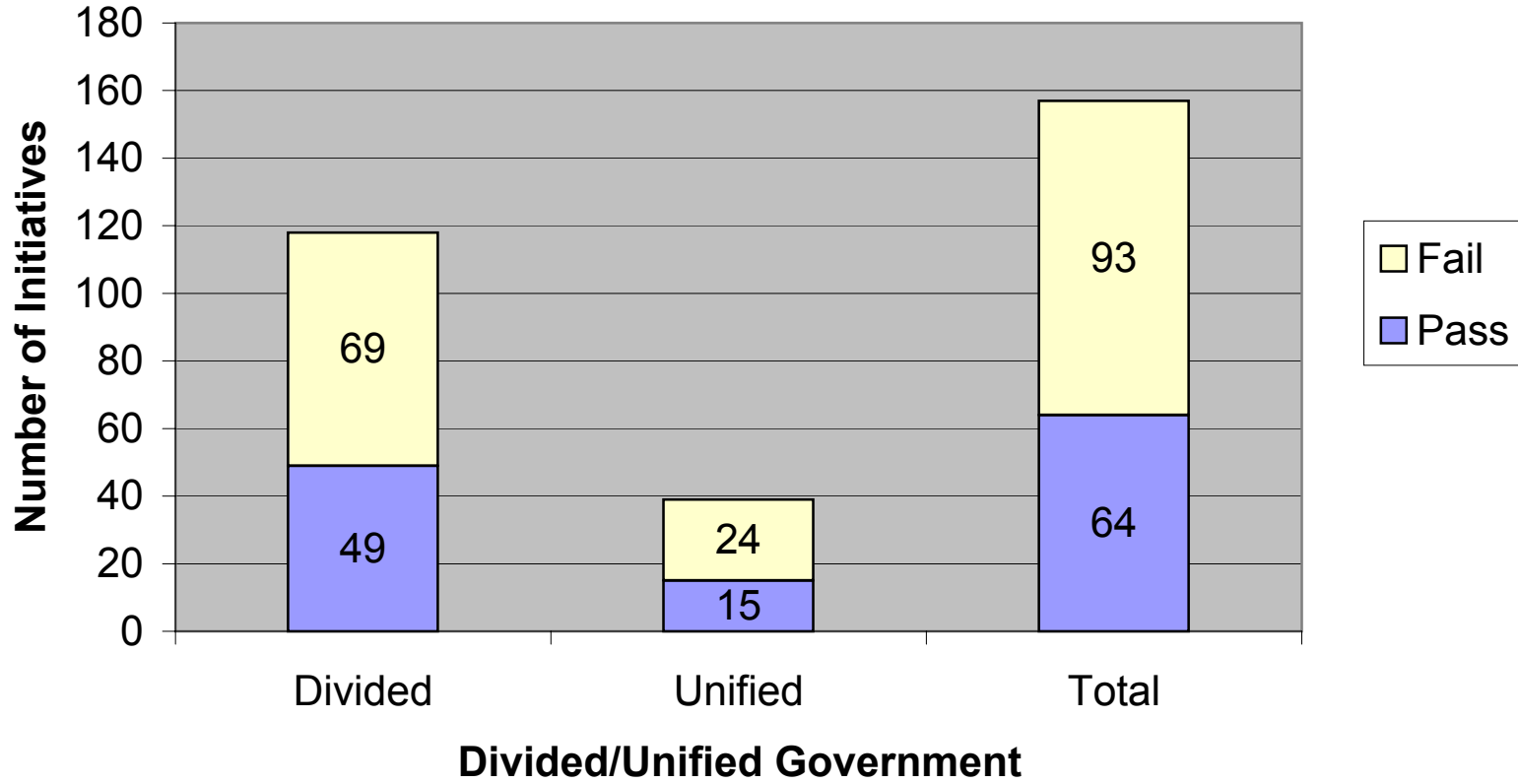
