
Fire Safety

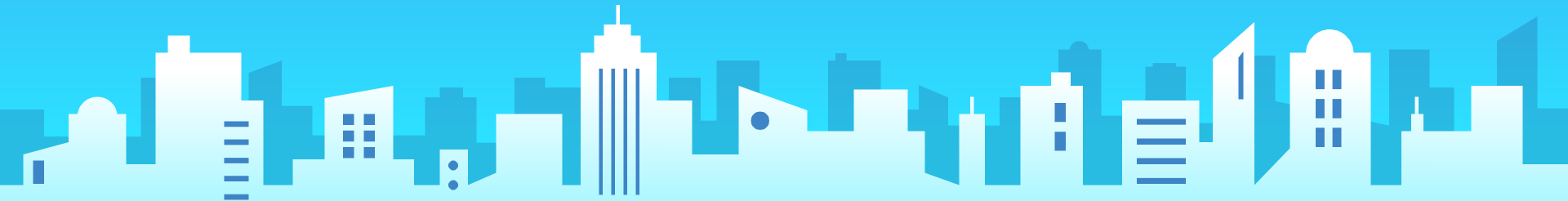

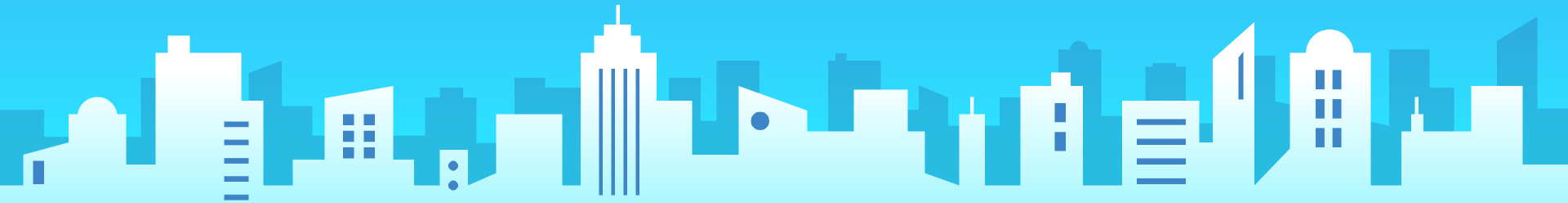

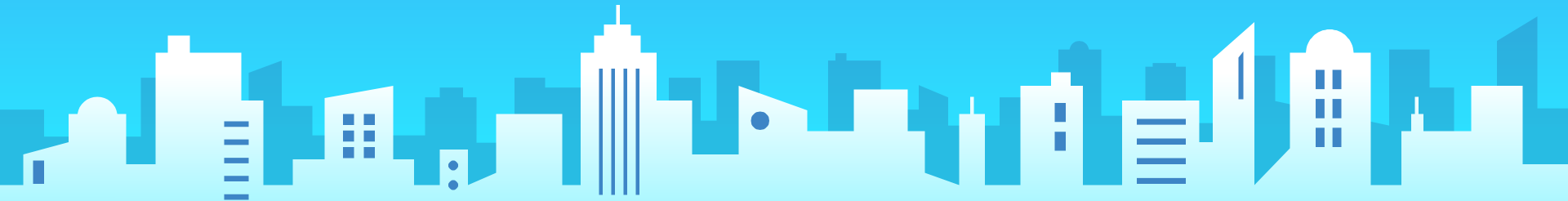

Conduct Violations

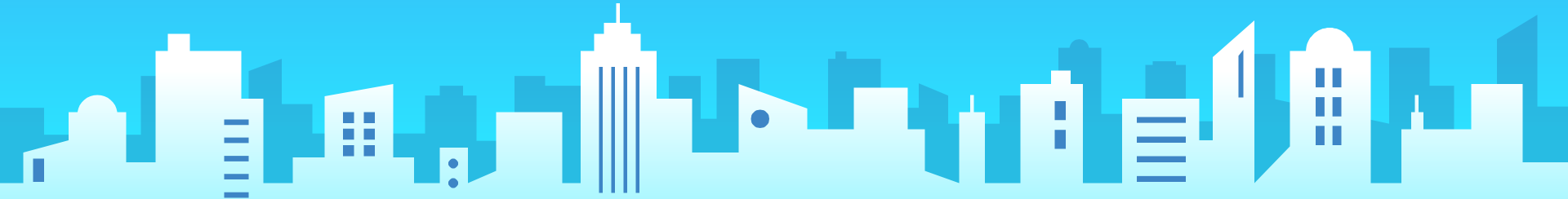


Student Conduct

- Violations sent to home campuses
- UC campuses: 7 years on your record
- Failure to pay fines or replacement costs may result in a freeze on your campus account (i.e. transcripts, class registration, diplomas)
- Removal from housing = Removal from academic program

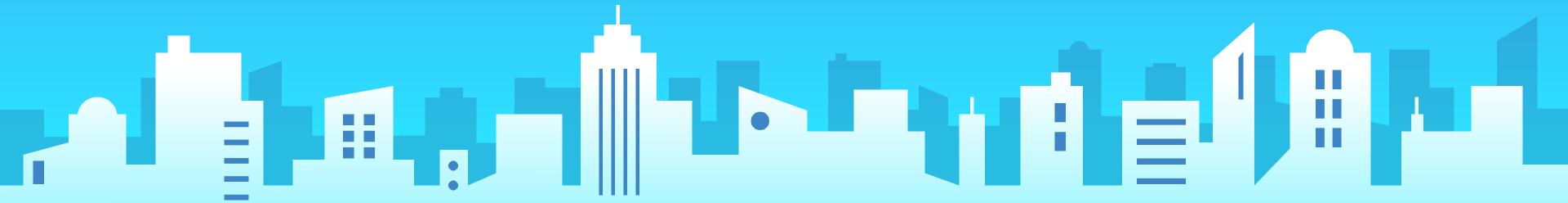
Alcohol Consumption

21+ years old: *Responsible drinking allowed (without other conduct violations)*

Under 21: *no drinking, responsible or otherwise*

Open Container Law: *no alcohol in public spaces...basically anywhere outside of your room*

Alcohol Volume: *kegs, 24+ packs, handles, etc. Empty alcohol containers = consumed alcohol*

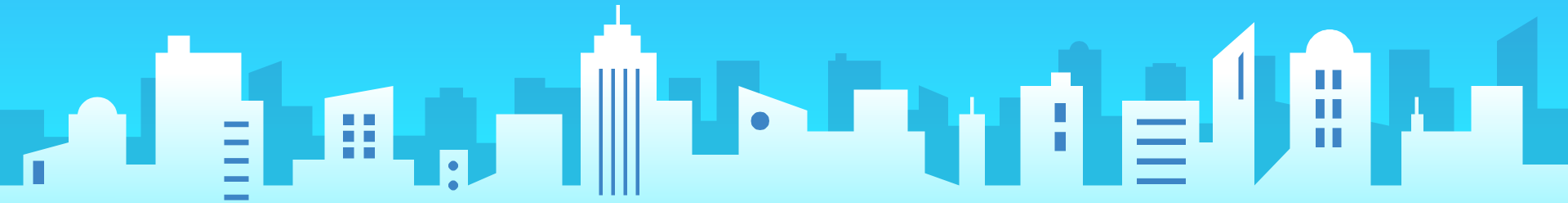

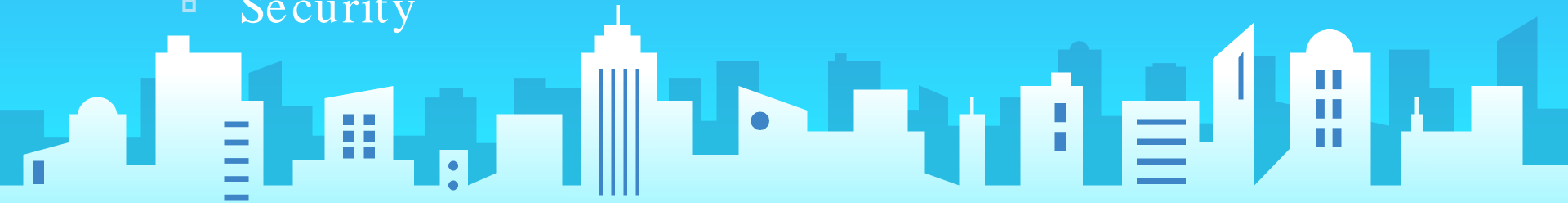



Sexual Misconduct and Title IX

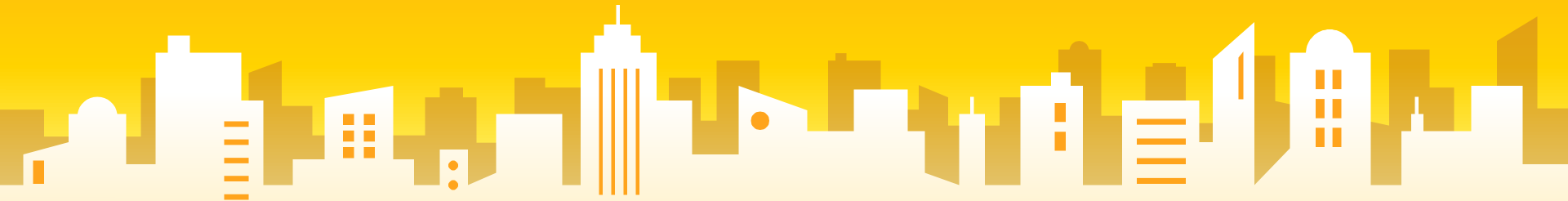

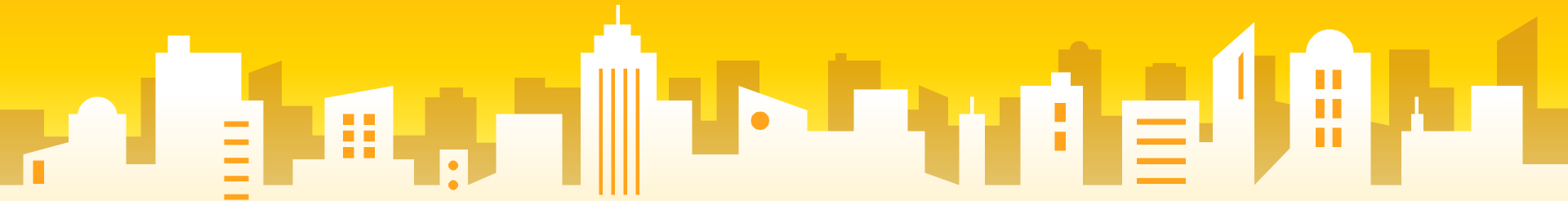

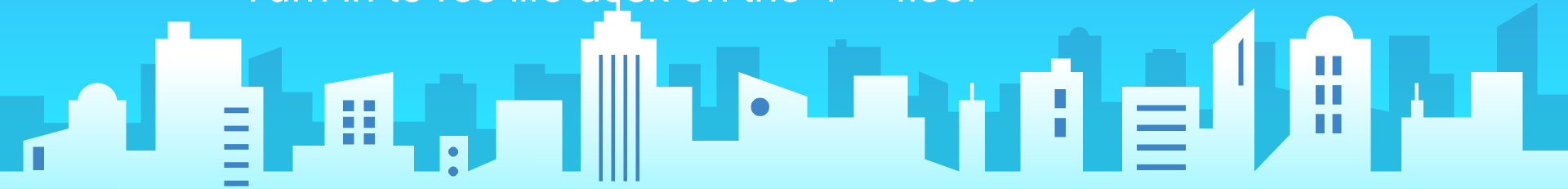

Step 1: Apartment Agreement Form

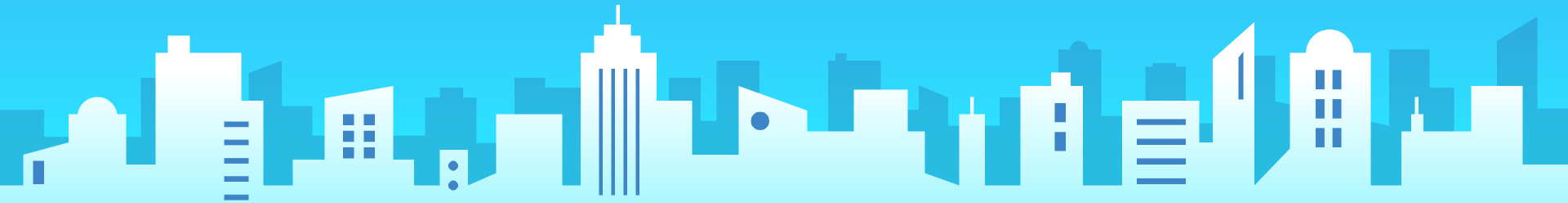
- NO GUESTS until Monday, January 13 at 2:00 PM.
- Apartment Agreement Form due BEFORE any guests are allowed (located in your mailbox)
- Please fill in every blank and circle all choices.
- All roommates need to sign before it can be turned in
- Do not use words like “anytime” or “whenever”
- If it is not descriptive enough, it will be given it back to you!
- Turn in to res life desk on the 4th floor





Step 2: Prior to Arrival

1. Maximum length of stay: 7 nights total (in 21 day period)
2. No more than 2 overnight guests per apartment per night
3. Check in your guest(s) with security
4. Your guest **MUST** have a government issued photo ID with them when checking in

UPass® (“University Pass”) is a discounted fare medium offering unlimited bus and rail rides on Metro to full-time undergraduate and graduate students throughout the academic year.

Works on MetroBus and MetroRail systems.

Does not work on circulator bus (red bus)

*Lost card? \$25 if you want it replaced, but must report it is lost even if you do not want a replacement. Only 1 replacement allowed.

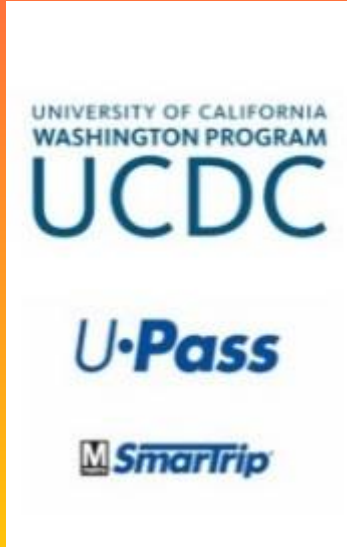

Card doesn't work? See station manager first.

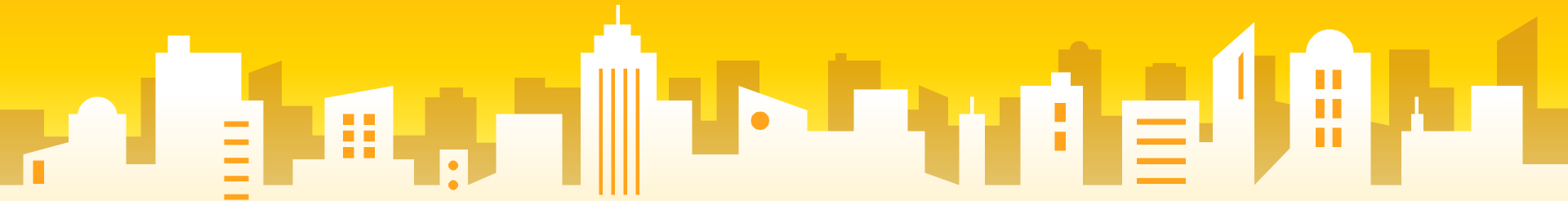

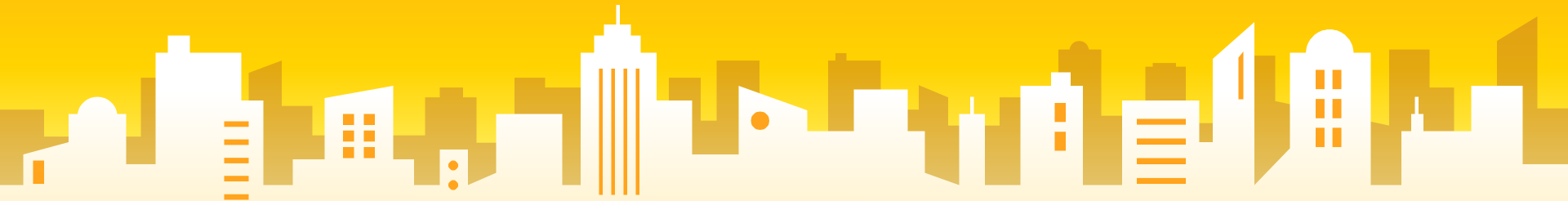
