We are thrilled to announce that Provost Michael Brown (University Office of the President) has approved our plan to welcome students back in person to the Washington Center this fall.

Our first priority is the health and safety of students and staff. Reopening will be contingent on the widespread availability of the vaccine, Washington, DC easing up on restrictions of in-person gathering (which would allow more internship offices to reopen), and DC ending its two-week quarantine requirement for those arriving from out of state. All UCDC students, faculty, and staff will be required to comply with any systemwide and/or campus vaccination requirement.

At this point, we are planning to reopen at half capacity. This will allow for single-occupancy bedrooms in each student apartment. (We will only charge students the double-occupancy rate.)

While much uncertainty remains about the factors that affect this decision, we are optimistic and are enthusiastically preparing to reopen our doors.
