Note: **PDF** attachments are preferred. Be sure to include your name in the title of *each* document for example:

(1) Mary Byrne Data Sheet, (2) Mary Byrne Short Essays

A complete application has the following components:

(1) Completed data sheet (see application form);

(2) Three short essay responses;

(3) Resume (not exceeding one page);

(4) Transcript;

(5) Two letters of recommendation; and

(6) Applicant's original writing sample (not to exceed more than five pages on any subject. Your UCDC application writing sample is also acceptable.)

✓ PART I: DATA SHEET (See application form)

✓ PART II: SHORT ESSAY RESPONSES

On a separate page, please answer with no more than 300 words per question (single spaced):

1) Why is public service important to you? Use examples of how you have demonstrated an interest or commitment to public service in the past.

2) Describe what role you anticipate public service will play in your career.

3) Name any individual – famous or not – whose public service you admire and explain how their contribution inspires you.

✓ PART III: CURRENT RESUME

• Please include a one-page resume highlighting your professional and academic accomplishments.

✓ PART IV: CURRENT TRANSCRIPT OR ONLINE GRADE PRINTOUT

• You do not need to have an official transcript for this part of the application. An online grade printout is sufficient.

✓ PART V: 2 LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

• You may use the same letters that you used to apply to the UCDC Program, or you may submit Fellowship-specific letters.

• Please scan and email your letters and send them with your application. If you do not have copies of your recommendation letters, please request your recommender submit a pdf copy of your letter directly to: <u>matsuifellowship@ucdc.edu</u> with your name in the subject line of the email.
